ABOUT THE ROLE

The Treasurer will join a highly committed and dynamic Board of Trustees and will play a central role in providing financial oversight for the Charity.

They will be responsible for monitoring and advising on financial viability and stability, and ensuring that proper financial records and procedures are maintained.



TIME COMMITMENT

This is an unremunerated role, with an expected time commitment of 10-12 days per year. This encompasses four board meetings annually and oversight of the Charity's financial affairs.

Board meetings usually take place on Zoom for a duration of two hours; with one day-long board meeting per year taking place in person (most likely in London).

ABOUT PLAN FOR PEACE



Plan for Peace is a charity founded in 2020 by three times Nobel Peace Prize nominee, Dr Scilla Elworthy. Our mission is to generate a groundswell of people from all sectors who believe that a world without destructive conflict is possible and necessary.

Based in the UK with a global reach, we have grown quickly. As well as receiving funds from grants and donations, our income is drawn from the profits of our sister organisation, Business Plan for Peace - a not-for-profit company that embeds conflict transformation and peacebuilding strategies in major global brands.

Plan for Peace is pioneering a new global strategy, which will support countries to have the capacity to spot dangers to internal peace and to solve problems before they spiral into violence.

Proof of concept work in ongoing and is likely to lead to the requirement of considerable added resources.

MAIN RESPONSIBILITIES

The Treasurer's key responsibilities are as follows:

- Maintain an overview of the charity's financial affairs.
- Ensure financial viability and stability.
- Ensure that proper financial records and procedures are maintained.

Additional responsibilities

- Safeguard the good name and values of the Charity.
- Declare any conflict of interest while carrying out the duties of a Trustee.
- Be collectively responsible for the actions of the Charity with other Trustees.
- Participate in additional tasks that could arise, such as interviewing new staff or advising on fundraising strategy.
- Contribute actively to the Board of Trustees' role in giving firm strategic direction to the Charity, setting overall policy, defining goals, setting targets and evaluating performance.

PERSONAL SPECIFICATION

As well as a commitment to our mission and values, we are seeking a person with sound financial knowledge, skills and qualifications.

Understanding of Charity finances and accounting for charitable funds desirable but not essential.

Our ideal candidate:

- Is committed to the work and values of the Charity, and is willing to devote the necessary time and effort to support it to grow and prosper.
- Possesses relevant financial qualifications and experience.
- Possesses strategic vision, good independent judgment and the ability to think creatively.
- Understands and accepts the legal duties, responsibilities and liabilities of trusteeship.
